Entrepreneurship Classes to Begin at Local Career Centers

Columbia State Community College and the South Central Tennessee Workforce Alliance have formed a partnership to offer a series of Entrepreneurship Training Classes in the fall, 2009. The first class of the series will be held at the Tennessee Career Center in Pulaski, Tuesday, October 6th at 6:00pm.

Topics to be covered in the training are *which business to start, marketing, legal structure, accounting for small business, cash flow, pricing of products or services, challenges of managing a small business, how to write a business plan, and, coaching on how to improve the business plans*. This training is suitable for prospective or current Small Business owners/Entrepreneurs. Participants will only be required to pay \$30 for the classes. The Workforce Alliance will pay the remainder of the tuition.

Trainers for these sessions are prior and current Entrepreneurs from the county where the training takes place. Speakers will also be professionals, consultants, educators, and representatives from the state Economic and Community Development department.
