Project Learn Educational Center

The Project Learn Educational Center offers numerous opportunities with a major focus on GED preparation for adults and out-of-school youth in Maury County. The program assists students in improving educational attainment levels and successfully entering employment and continuing education. “The staff is dedicated and knowledgeable” states Sheryl Jordan, director of the program, “and this year we have a special class for dislocated workers and a Fast Track course”.

Services are free and instruction is provided in basic skills, GED preparation, and English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL). **The Basic Skills Class** improves reading, math and writing skills, while our most popular class, the **GED** (General Educational Development) prepares students to pass the high school equivalency test. Each year the program holds a graduation ceremony for GED graduates, family and friends. **English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) class** serves non-native speakers who need to learn or improve their English.

The center is associated with the Tennessee Career Center in Columbia, and is located in Northway Shopping Center. Registration is every Wednesday at Project Learn Educational Center from 8:30 am to 1:00 pm. Day and evening classes are available at the Project Learn Educational Center and at other locations within the county. **Call 490-3811 for more information.**
