A meeting of the South Central Tennessee Annual P-16 Council Meeting will be held on Wednesday, October 14, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. at the Tennessee Career Center 113 Factory Street, Linden, TN

The purpose of the legislation is to enable each state and locality to develop a unified training system that will "increase the employment, retention, and earnings by participants, and as a result improve the quality of the workforce, reduce welfare dependency, and enhance the productivity and competitiveness of the nation." Local Workforce Investment Area Ten is composed of the following counties: Giles, Hickman, Lawrence, Lewis, Marshall, Maury, Perry and Wayne. South Central Tennessee Workforce Alliance is the administrative entity for the program.
